Application for a Junior Coaching Bursary 2018

Bursaries up to £100 are available to amateur junior girls under 18 on 1st January 2018. They are aimed at developing potential talent so are not purely based on current ability. They allow for a girl to retain their current coach, rather than have county coaching in a group session which may be with a different coach. They could also be used to address a specific skill gap with a specialist coach such as short game, psychology or strength and conditioning coach if required.

Applicants should complete Section 1 of this form and then forward to your Professional coach to complete Section 2. Your Pro should then submit the fully completed form by Sunday April 29th 2018.

Bursaries will be awarded in early May and must be used by the end of September. Following which a feedback form must be completed by the applicant and submitted to NCLGA.
